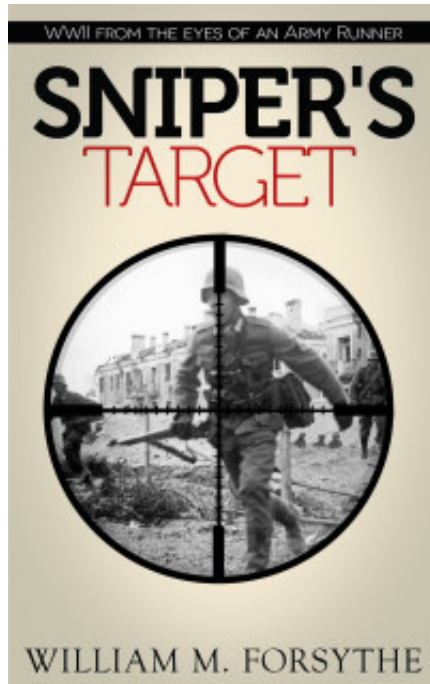


## An Unsung Hero: Sniper's Target

The experiences of Jimmy Ray Lewis, a runner in the 104th Division of the United States in World War II, were shared by many during the worldwide conflict between the Allies and the Axis. Drafted in June 1944, he joined the 104th Infantry division nicknamed the "Timberwolves" and renown for their progress fighting at night. Jimmy spent more than six months on the front lines including the Battle of the Bulge and meeting the Russians in Germany, the beginning of the end.

His story is more than battles and fire fights, but reveals the day to day frustrations, fears, and worries of a common soldier, a man who answered the call, did his duty, and went home to a new family and life.
